Results of Child Abuse and Neglect:

- Four children die everyday
- 59% more likely to be arrested as a juvenile
- 28% more likely to be arrested as an adult
- 30% more likely to commit a violent crime
- 30% will later abuse their own children, continuing the cycle of abuse

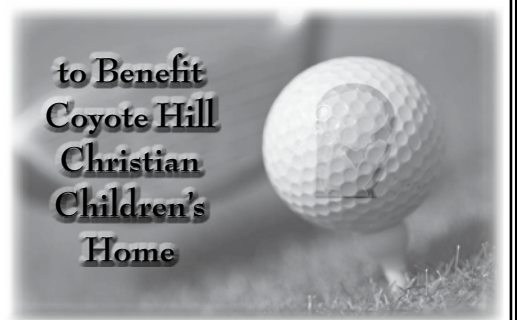

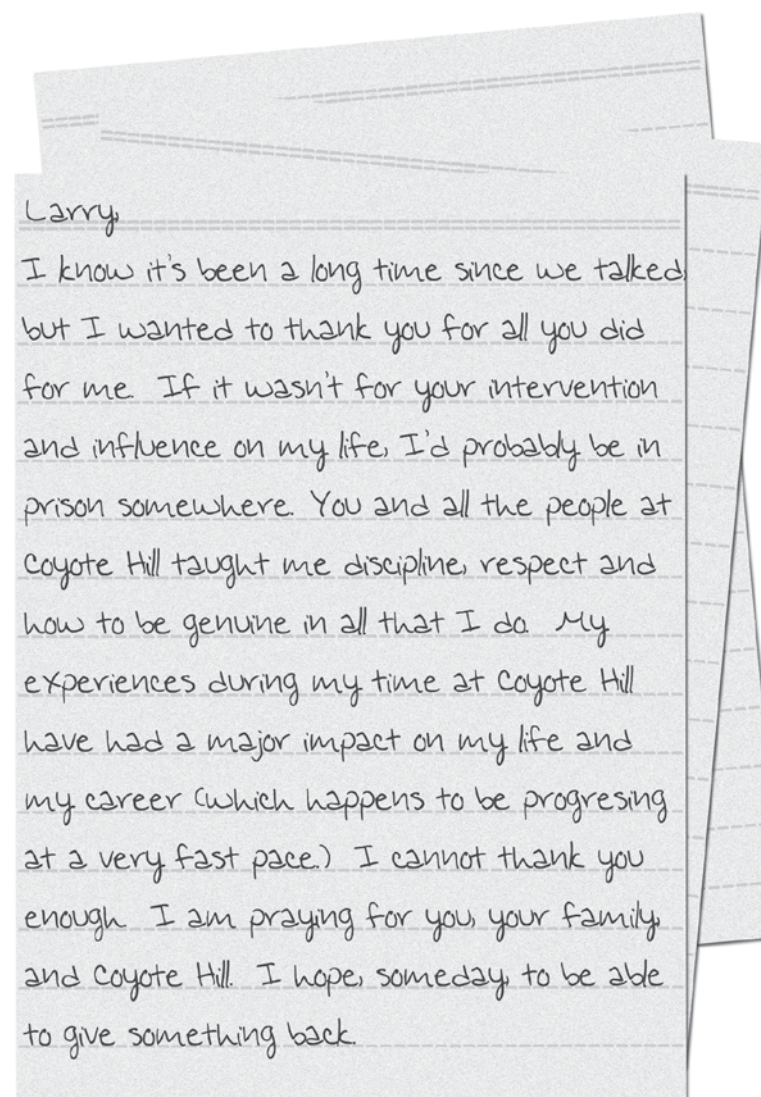
